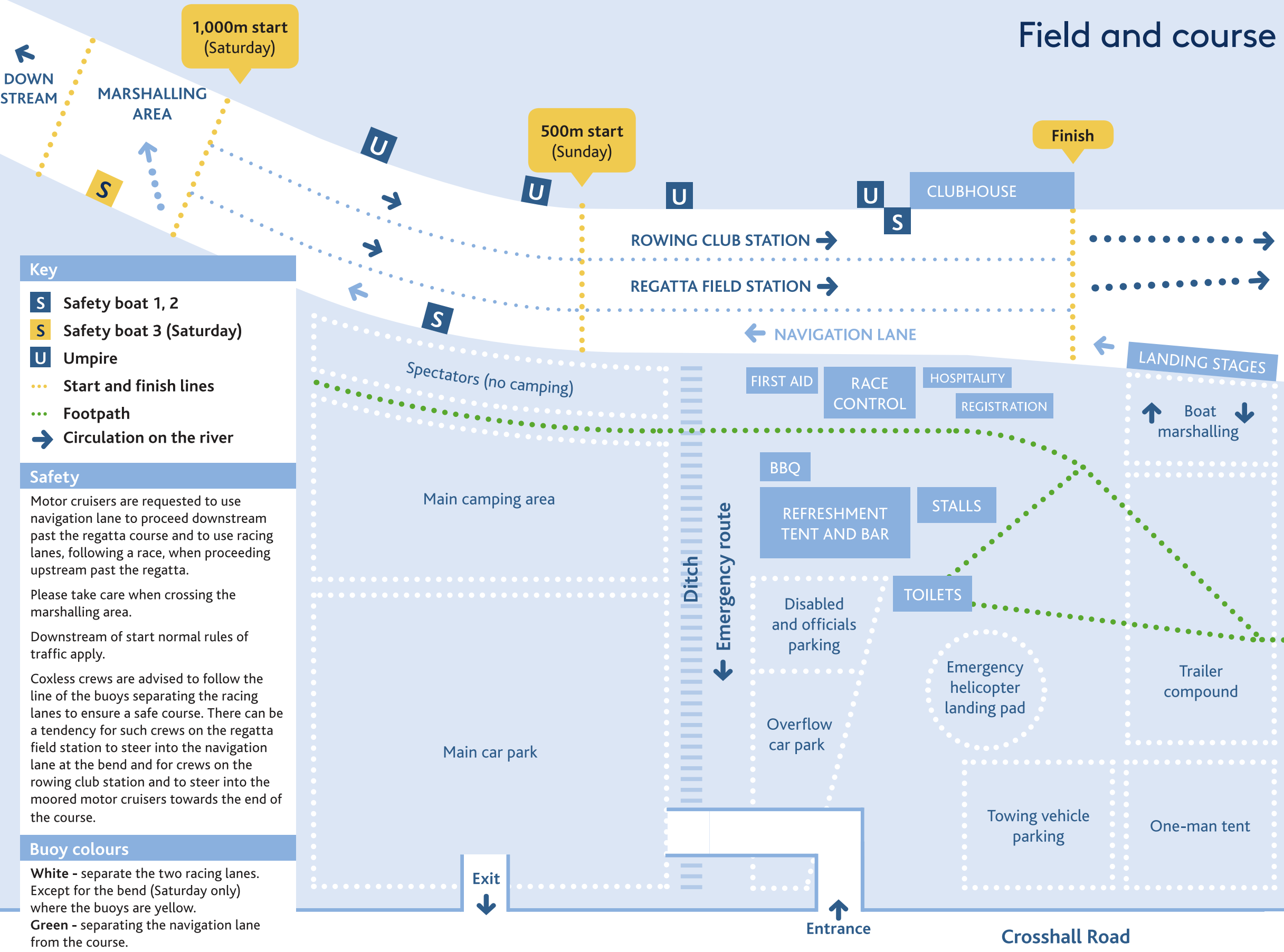


Field and course

Safety

Motor cruisers are requested to use navigation lane to proceed downstream past the regatta course and to use racing lanes, following a race, when proceeding upstream past the regatta.

Please take care when crossing the marshalling area.

Downstream of start normal rules of traffic apply.

Coxless crews are advised to follow the line of the buoys separating the racing lanes to ensure a safe course. There can be a tendency for such crews on the regatta field station to steer into the navigation lane at the bend and for crews on the rowing club station and to steer into the moored motor cruisers towards the end of the course.

Buoy colours

White - separate the two racing lanes. Except for the bend (Saturday) where the buoys are yellow.

Green - separating the navigation lane from the course.

Red floating barrier - marks the side of racing lane (where river bank diverts excessively from the course).
