

COVID-19 Safety Information



Prior to the Event

Please do not attend the event if you have:

1. Tested positive for COVID-19 within ten days prior to the event.
2. Are showing symptoms of COVID-19 (continuous cough, fever, loss of smell/taste)

We recommend all visitors take a lateral flow test the evening prior to the event.

During the Event

- **Face Coverings** We recommend wearing a face covering in the following instances:
 - When walking around inside the Clubhouse building; and
 - When you are unable to maintain two metres from others for a prolonged period of time anywhere on the Club premises.
- **Spare Face Coverings** A limited supply of spare face coverings will be available should any visitor or volunteer require one – these will be available to pick up from the barbeque under the balcony.
- **One-Way System** There will be a one-way system in place in the Clubhouse building – please follow the signage (enter via the normal Clubhouse entrance, exit via the fire exit at the far end of the building).
- **Social Distancing** Whilst we acknowledge the close proximity of the premises and the number of visitors attending the event, we encourage all visitors and volunteers to try and maintain a two-metre distance between others where possible. If this is not possible for a prolonged period of time, we encourage the wearing of a face covering.
- **NHS Track & Trace QR Codes** These will be displayed throughout the Club premises – please make sure to check in using the NHS COVID-19 app.
- **Registration** To minimise the number of people gathering at Registration, we recommend one representative from each visiting club be responsible for collecting all of the race numbers for their club's competitors at the start of the day.
- **Hand Sanitisers** These will be available for use throughout the Club premises.
- **Toilets** We advise that only one person enter the toilets at any time. Please avoid queuing for these in the Clubhouse building.
- **Provision for Equipment Sanitation** Please note that the Club will **not** be able to provide sanitation equipment for boats for visiting competitors. It is competitors' responsibility to ensure their equipment is appropriately sanitised before, during and after the event.
- **Changing Facilities** Please note that the changing facilities at the Club will be **closed**. Showers will only be available to competitors who have been involved in a capsized.
