Juniors who have competed at national events in any boat or won races at local regattas are expected to race in the Main Head. The Race Committee reserves the right to reallocate Mini Head entries into the Main Head based on crew competency/experience.

Main Head: £10.00 per seat. Mini Head: £6.00 per seat.

All entries to be made via BROE2. Entries close at 12:00pm on Saturday 25 September. Entries for each division may be suspended earlier if full capacity is reached. Online payments only via BROE2.

Please note any acceptable alternative events on your entry (there must be at least two entries to run an event). 'Time-only' will be available only if there is space. In the event of cancellation, 10% of entry fees will be withheld to cover fixed administration costs.

The draw will take place at 12:00pm on Sunday 26 September at St Neots Rowing Club, and will be published on the Club website shortly afterwards.

Pewter tankards for all winners in the Main Head with two or more entries. Medals for all winners in the Mini Head. The Harry Evans Memorial Trophy will be presented to the most successful club in the Main Head. Prizegiving will take place as soon as possible after Division 4 in front of the Boathouse.

Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each division, with the final results being published on the Club website and Twitter feed.
